Did you know?

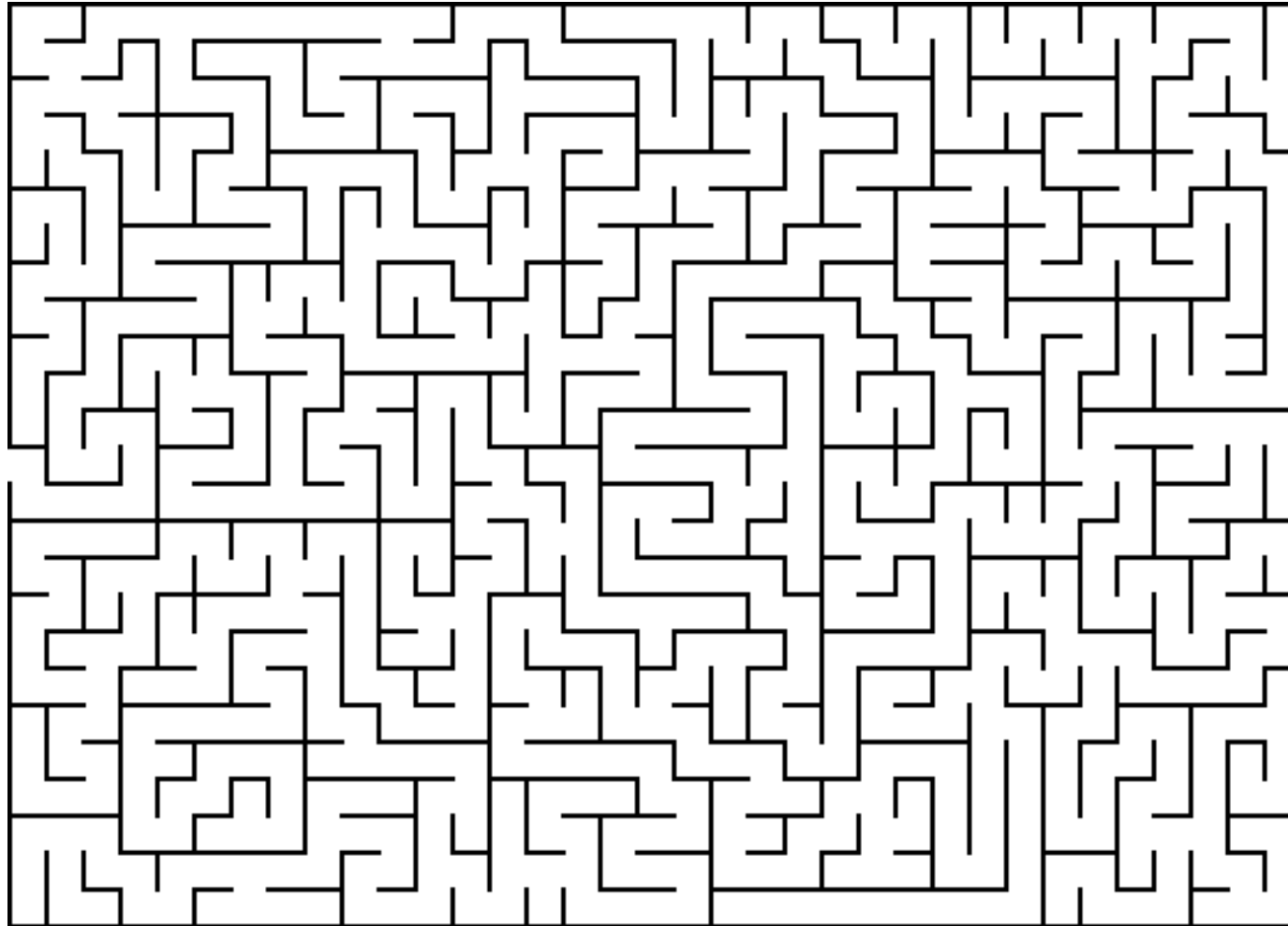
1. The first rocket to fly by the Moon was in December 1968. It didn't land on the Moon, it just went around and came back to Earth to prove the journey was possible.

2. The first person to walk on the Moon was Neil Armstrong who



stepped onto the Moon on 20th July 1969.

4. It took three days to fly to the Moon. The astronauts stayed there for one day and then flew back to Earth. So they were gone from Earth for a whole week.



Did you know?

5. The same side of the Moon always faces the Earth. This means the only way we can see the other side is to fly around the Moon to take a look.

6. It takes about four seconds for the sunlight reflected by



the Moon to travel through space to the Earth. This means when you look up and see the Moon, the light you're seeing left the Moon 4 seconds ago.
